SPILL CLEAN-UP - Procedure

Basic steps to be taken in the event of a hazardous material spill:

- 1. Assess the situation
- 2. Notify Management
- 3. Restrict entry into the spill area
- 4. Control the spill
- 5. Begin clean-up as soon as the situation is stabilised
- 6. Prepare a written report of the spill

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Protective equipment must be worn for hazardous spill clean-up. As a minimum Nitrile Gloves or equivalent. Depending on the type & scope of the spill other protective equipment to be used can include;

Impervious Body Coveralls with Hood & Boots Respirator, mask and / or face shield Chemical Splash Goggles
